2016 N.J. DOG LICENSE APPLICATION

Dog Licenses are due for renewal by January 31, 2016, but cannot be renewed before January 2, 2016.

The fees are: \$20.00 if spayed or neutered or \$23.00 if not.

Per ordinance #1,555 chapter 11-2.3 **a late fee of \$15.00 per dog** will be imposed after **January 31, 2016.** (Does not apply to new dog applications)

**WE MUST HAVE PROOF OF RABIES VACCINATION
GOOD THROUGH OCTOBER 31, 2016 IN ORDER TO ISSUE A LICENSE.**

All new applications must show proof of spayed/neutered (if applicable)

Return this form, any applicable copies of paperwork and a check in the appropriate amount payable to the Borough of Lincoln Park. Your new tag will be mailed to you. Please notify the Health Department if you no longer own your dog. Please do not send cash through the mail.

CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR PET

Many Municipalities and public agencies must enact and enforce local pet-waste rules. An example is requiring pet owners or their keepers to pick up and properly dispose of pet waste dropped on public or other people's property. Make sure you know your town's or Agency's requirements and comply with them. It's the law. Per ordinance 106-7.1 you must clean up all pet waste. And remember to: Use newspaper, bags or pooper-scoopers to pick up wastes. Dispose of the wrapped pet waste in the trash or unwrapped in a toilet. Never discard pet waste in a storm drain.
