

COMMINGLED CONTAINER

Items should be rinsed, no food in or on recyclables. Smaller items can be placed in the blue barrel. Blue labels are available to place on your own containers and can also be obtained at Borough Hall in Clerk's Office.

RIGID PLASTIC: Molded Lawn Chairs, Buckets, Toys
ALUMINUM/METAL: Soda Cans
 Cans: soup, Food, Coffee, Etc.
 Pots & Pans

GLASS

NOT ACCEPTABLE MATERIAL

Bagged materials (even containing recyclables)
 No Plastic Bags
 No Glassware (cookware, bakeware, autoglass)
 No Ceramics/Dishes
 No Household items such as hangers, pots, toasters, etc.
 No Styrofoam

ITEMS ACCEPTED AT RECYCLING CENTER



RECHARGEABLE, Button Cell, Lithium and Lead Acid which are used for cars and motorcycles can be brought to Recycling Center and deposited in designated area.
ALKALINE BATTERIES: Such as AAA, AA, C, D AND 9-volts can be and should be thrown out in the garbage



MOTOR OIL: Used Motor Oil should be in a clean container with tight fitting lid. There is a 5 Gal. limit at any one time. Must be deposited in the approved shed.
Do not empty containers into the bins or storage drums.



TIRES: We Accept Car Tires, Motorcycle Tires, And Light Truck Tires that are deposited in the designated spot.
 No Tires over 17" Rim or Equipment Tires will be Accepted



SCRAP METAL: All Metals are Recyclable. Examples Include but not limited to: pipe, metal railings, screens, Gym sets, bicycles, Appliances, hot water heaters. **NO PROPANE TANKS**



ELECTRONICS RECYCLING: Consist of Computers, Laptops, Monitors, Televisions, Printers, Fax, copiers, and scanners. Computer Peripherals including keyboards, mouse, and other devices.



SHREDDING DAY: There is a 30 lb. Limit per Lincoln Park resident with ID. Place documents in a box or paper bag, free of clips, rubber bands and metal. No wet paper, newspapers, cardboard, books, magazines or other bond items. Oct. (TBA) & May (TBA). Time: 9AM - 1PM. Place: Brough Hall Parking Lot.



CLOTHES BIN: No blankets or pillows – will accept clothes, paired shoes, handbags, linens, stuffed animals, small toys (no board games, puzzles or toys with pieces)
REUSE/RECYCLE BOOK BIN: Nothing wet or molded, no encyclopedias – will accept books, magazines, children's books.

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED AT BOROUGH RECYCLING CENTER



HAZARD MATERIALS: For disposal of Oil base paints, Gasoline, Thinners, Solvents, Anti-Freeze, Pool Chemicals and any other Hazardous Materials. Please call Morris County MUA at 973-829-8006 to make Appointment at their facility or get information when and where they are having a Hazardous Collection Day. LATEX Paint: Cans should be opened, Mixed with Cat litter or speedy Dry, allowed to dry and harden, then put in with regular trash with lids off – Not Recycling



CONCRETE, ASPHALT, BRICKS AND CINDER BLOCKS: Will not be accepted. This includes, but not limited to Sidewalk pieces, Driveway pieces, Cinder Blocks. Materials can be taken to :

CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS: Is not Accepted, Residents or their Contractors are responsible for the disposal of the Material. Construction Debris includes, but is not limited to: Wood, Roof shingles, Ceramic Tile, Tar Paper, Replacement Windows, Sheetrock and Linoleum. YARD WASTE POLICIES FOR LINCOLN PARK



Grass & Vegetative Waste: The Borough will collect grass based upon the availability of DPW workers on or about the dates listed in the Town Planner or residents may deposit their grass in the designated area at the Recycling Center. Grass must be in paper bio-degradable lawn and leaf bags or barrels, not to exceed 45 lbs. OR 35 gals. and must be clearly marked.
NO LANDSCAPE BARRELS



Leaves: Must be bagged in a paper bio-degradable Leaf and Lawn bag and free of any Garbage or other debris and or Barrel not to exceed 50 lbs. Leaf bags shall be put at the curb no earlier than 24 hrs before scheduled pick-up, starting in October.



Brush: The Borough and/or Private Contractor will collect residential brush. All brush and branches shall not exceed 3 inches in diameter and no longer than 6 ft long and must be tied and / or bundled in a manageable pile with stick ends facing in one direction. Brush should be placed at the curb line **not in the roadway** no earlier than 24 hrs ahead of your scheduled pick-up

BULK – CURBSIDE AND RECYCLING CENTER DROP-OFF



Bulk will be picked up 4 times a year. Pick-up is determined by your route number. The schedule is included in this brochure. Items that will be picked up include: **Furniture, Appliances, Lawn Mowers, Hot Water Heaters, Mattresses & Box Springs and similar bulk Items.** Items should not be put out more than 24 hrs in advance of pick-up. Bulk Items for the Compactor can be dropped off by residents on Friday 7:00 AM to 3:15 PM & Saturday 8:00 AM to 4:15 PM.



Items not collected: Auto parts, Tires, construction debris, roofing material, cement, asphalt, hazard waste, paint, paint thinners, household garbage and electronics: **i.e. televisions, computers, monitors, etc.**
