With a quick and inexpensive **Home Energy Audit**, homeowners can learn precisely where they can make improvements to conserve energy in the home. **Rebate and loan programs** exist to assist homeowners through the process and help offset the costs of installing upgrades.

WHAT IS AN ENERGY AUDIT?

A Home Energy Audit is a **comprehensive assessment** of the efficiency of the home. The tests are conducted by **certified technicians**, employed by Building Performance Institute-certified contractors. Once the audit is complete, the homeowner receives a follow-up report with **suggested home improvements** and available **financial incentives**.

HOW DO I GET STARTED?

Step 1: Schedule a Home Energy Audit

For a partial list of certified contractors near you, please see pages 2 and 3 of this document. The Audit is typically performed in about three hours. It is recommended you request an additional **blower test** if you intend to insulate or weatherize your home.

Step 2: Receive Recommendations and Identify Financial Incentives

The New Jersey Clean Energy Program (NJCEP) currently offers three tiers of **rebates** and **zero-interest loans** to homeowners who qualify for the Home Performance with ENERGY STAR (HPwES) program:

Tier 2: Homeowners with an estimated total energy savings (TES) of between five and 20 percent. **\$2,000 rebate**, zero-interest loan of up to \$5,000.

Tier 3, Level 1: Estimated TES of between 20 and 25 percent. **\$3,000 rebate**, zero-interest loan of up to \$10,000 if utility loans are not available.

Tier 3, Level 2: Estimated TES of over 25 percent. **\$4,000 rebate**, zero-interest loan of up to \$10,000 if utility loans are not available.

Combined with financial incentives from NJCEP, improving the energy efficiency of your home produces **excellent cost-savings**, in addition to **reducing your environmental impact**.
