Waivers and Code of Conduct

One (1) Waiver for per Family

Parents are required to complete on behalf of children under the age of 18 years

All Adult Members are required to sign individually

- Each Single Family unit will be required to complete **one** Waiver and Consent, **one** Code of Conduct Form and one COVID-19 Waiver as part of its Registration;
- Proof of Residency is REQUIRED to be eligible for In-Town Registration Rates (current license, utility bill, etc.);
- All Family Members must be listed on each form, and children will require an adult's signature (see below*);
- Multiple Families at the same address are required to complete a separate Registration, Waiver and Consent/Code of Conduct Form;
- **Adults/Members Age 18/Over:** Waiver and Consent/Code of Conduct must be signed on your own behalf (an adult cannot sign for another adult, unless you are that adult's legal guardian).
- ***Children/Members Age 18/Under:** A Parent/Guardian must sign the Waiver and Consent/Code of Conduct, on behalf of **every** Child under the age of 18years old.
- **All Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult/guardian (per revised N.J.A.C. 8:26-5.1(a)2.(d)1)**

The Recreation Department advocates and supports membership programs in Lincoln Park. The Borough proudly offers membership with the Lincoln Park Community Lake. Membership is subject to the observance of rules and procedures. The activities outlined below are **strictly prohibited**. Any participants, volunteers or staff members who violate this code are subject to discipline, up to and including removal from the program.

- Abusive language towards a staff member, volunteer, or other participant.
- Discourtesy or rudeness to a fellow participant, staff member, or volunteer.
- Verbal, physical, or visual harassment of another participant, staff member, or volunteer.
- Bullying or taking unfair advantage of any participant.
- Failure to cooperate with adult supervisor/leader/mentor.
- Possession or usage of alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs on the Borough of Lincoln Park property or reporting to the program while under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- Possession of dangerous or unauthorized materials such as firearms, weapons, or other similar items on Borough property.
- Conduct endangering the life, safety, health or well-being of others.
- Failure to leave area in the condition in which you found it, including restrooms, gym, hallways, and any other area used. Defacing or destruction of any Borough property regardless of condition or value.
- Failure to follow any Department of Recreation policy & procedures.

The current world-wide Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic and government mandated “shelter in place/stay at home” orders, social distancing guidelines or similar re-opening orders in many communities underscore the risks associated with individuals participating in Borough of Lincoln Park sponsored recreation events and/or using recreation parks and/or facilities.

The virus is an extremely dangerous and communicable disease. It spreads easily through person-to-person contact and as well as via contaminated objects. Federal and state authorities recommend, at a minimum, social distancing, facial masks/coverings, frequent handwashing or sanitizing and temperature checks as a means to prevent the spread of the virus.

As with any communicable disease caused by a virus, including COVID-19, you can become severely ill. You may be more susceptible to contracting a communicable disease from a virus, including COVID-19, if you have certain pre-existing health conditions.

The Borough of Lincoln Park follows the Federal CDC protocols for disinfection, which include public areas that can be disinfected. The Borough of Lincoln Park cannot guarantee that a communicable disease from a virus, including COVID-19, will not be present should you choose to participate in a recreation sponsored activity or make use of any Borough facility.

By signing this agreement, you have read and agree to accept all health risks associated with participation in a Borough recreation program and/or use of its facilities. You also agree to be a responsible person and not participate, or have your child participate, in any Borough recreation program and/or use of its facilities should you or your child have any symptoms of a communicable disease from a virus, including COVID-19.

By signing below, you agree to release and hold harmless the Borough of Lincoln Park, its directors, employees, agents, vendors, contractors and volunteers from and against all claims for damages and liability resulting from exposure to disease-causing organisms, such as COVID-19, and contaminated objects, as well as personal contact associated with participation in a Borough recreation program and/or use of its facilities.
